## Covid-19 Cycling and Walking Emergency Response Measures

### Proposed segregated cycleways on Meadow Place Road

Please be advised that as part of overall emergency measures we are proposing to implement segregated cycleways on Meadow Place Road to help pedestrians and cyclists travel safely while meeting physical distancing requirements.

I have attached the proposed designs for the scheme. In summary it shows:

- Introduction of uni-directional segregated cycleways along Meadow Place Road

Given the urgency to make the required changes any comments relating to these proposals should be received by **1200hrs on Tuesday 14 July** to [spacesforpeople@edinburgh.gov.uk](mailto:spacesforpeople@edinburgh.gov.uk).

All feedback will be reviewed and where possible the scheme will be further refined. Feedback will be summarised in an assessment feedback form which will be presented to the Council Incident Management Team for approval. Please note that we will be unable to respond to individual emails.
